Please Note: In accordance with the published policy there will be an additional opportunity to qualify a further junior C2 and junior C1W at the Pan Celtic race on Sunday May 30th 2010 in Nottingham.

The International Panel may consider the inclusion of an additional C2 crew and C1W paddlers by looking at the top finishing junior C2 and top two finishing junior C1W not already selected regardless of the previous selection order at this May race. The International Panel may consider additional selection based on reference to performance standards. The race is open to any junior C2 crew or C1W paddlers and all paddlers wishing to paddle should apply for ranking status in P / 1 or 2 / 3. Publication of any additional places will be made during the following week by the International Panel.

Please note that in line with the published policy athletes selected for U23 and senior teams are required to confirm their planned summer's racing within 7 days of the final selection race.

The International Panel would like to express how impressed they have been throughout the junior, U23 and Senior races at the standard of competition across all classes. The quality of competition is reflected in the number of reserves named by achieving published standards and recognition of those performances.

Athletes not receiving funding support are reminded that they should write to their National Governing Body Slalom Committee (Canoe Wales, SCA Slalom Committee or England Canoe Slalom) if they wish to be considered for a contribution to costs.
